The tenth annual AGEP Summer Research Institute at Stony Brook University

May 30 to August 1, 2009

The AGEP Summer Research Institute is an intensive residential research internship program for underrepresented minority undergraduates majoring in science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM).

Students will get a unique opportunity to work on independent research projects in cutting-edge laboratories under the direction of Stony Brook University faculty.

All AGEP Interns will receive:

- A stipend of \$3,500
- Round-trip airfare (if applicable)
- Free housing and a meal plan
- Seminars, field trips, and tours of local attractions

The program includes:

- Research Symposium
- Writing workshop
- Research methods seminar
- Workshops on graduate school opportunities
- Activities and field trips to NYC and the surrounding area

All AGEP SRI participants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Have an interest in pursuing graduate study
- Be U.S. citizens or permanent residents
- Be undergraduates entering their junior or senior year of study majoring in a science, technology, engineering, or mathematics discipline with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Be committed to increasing participation in STEM among the following ethnic groups: African American, Hispanics, American Indians, Alaska Natives, Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders
