Did You Know?

- Over 200 million ink jet & laser cartridges go to a landfill or an incinerator every year
- In the past 5 years, HP alone has recycled 31 million LaserJet cartridges, diverting around 40 thousand tons of waste from landfill sites around the world. This is the approximate weight of 500 Boeing 747 plane.
- Throughout the world millions of tons of hard, non-biodegradable plastic and loose toner powder are deposited in landfill sites and incinerators from cartridges and inkjets which ought to be recycled.
- The average toner cartridge weighs 3 lbs. That's about 120 million lbs that could be recycled every year.
- Laserjet cartridges are 40% plastic, 40% metal and small amounts of paper, foam, rubber, and toner. Altogether, it contains about 97% recyclable materials.

How do I Recycle My LaserJet Cartridge?

1. Make sure your toner cartridge is empty and is included on our list of acceptable cartridges*.
2. When you are replacing the empty cartridge, place it inside of the plastic bag that contained the new cartridge and seal it.
3. Replace the bag in its original configuration inside the box, seal it, and send it via inter-office mail to:

4. An outside provider will then pick them up and take them to a facility where they can be refilled or recycled and redistributed
