

National Science Foundation Robert Noyce Scholarship Program

\$10,000/\$20,000 Scholarship

APPLICATION

Recipients must meet the following criteria:

- ◆ be a full-time undergraduate or graduate student pursuing teaching certification in mathematics or a science discipline
- ◆ commit to teach in a high-needs secondary school for a minimum of two years within 4 years of graduating
- ◆ have an outstanding academic record – minimum 3.0 GPA
- ◆ be either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Application requirements:

- ◆ one essay demonstrating commitment to high needs schools (typed, one page or less)
- ◆ one essay describing a teacher you have had as a role model and why you would like to emulate that teacher (typed, one page or less)
- ◆ letters of recommendation (graduate students: we will access your letters of recommendation from your MAT application; undergraduates must submit two letters of recommendation)
- ◆ transcript (graduate students: we will access your transcript(s) from your MAT application; undergraduates must submit all college transcripts)
- ◆ interview of applicants

Commitment:

My signature below indicates my understanding that, if I am a Noyce Scholarship recipient:

- ◆ I will complete the teacher certification program in mathematics or a science discipline.
- ◆ I am obligated to teach full-time as a licensed teacher in mathematics or science in a high-needs public school for a minimum of two years within 4 years of graduating.
- ◆ Stony Brook University has my permission to track my progress through licensure and employment using my social security number.
- ◆ I will provide Stony Brook University with current employment and contact information throughout the period of my teaching obligation.
- ◆ I will participate in outcomes assessment activities designed to evaluate the effectiveness of the Noyce Scholarship program.
- ◆ I will attend a meetings and summer programs for scholarship recipients.
- ◆ I will sign a promissory note stating my intention to uphold these commitments or repay the funds received through this scholarship program.
