APPLICATION

Recipients must meet the following criteria:

- ◆ be pursuing either a BS/MAT or MAT degree and teacher certification in mathematics, science, or TESOL at Stony Brook University
- ◆ commit to student teaching in the New York City public school system
- ◆ commit to teach in the New York City public schools for a minimum of three years
- ◆ have an outstanding academic record – minimum 3.0 GPA
- ◆ be either a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

Application requirements:

- ◆ one essay describing what you hope to accomplish by teaching in the New York City public schools (typed, one page or less)
- ◆ two letters of recommendation
- ◆ all transcripts
- ◆ interview of selected applicants

Commitment:

My signature below indicates my understanding that, if I am a Petrie Scholarship Loan recipient:

- ◆ I will complete the teacher certification program in mathematics, science, or TESOL.
- ◆ I am obligated to student teach in the New York City public school system
- ◆ I am obligated to teach full-time as a licensed teacher in mathematics, science, or TESOL in a New York City public school for a minimum of three years.
- ◆ Stony Brook University has my permission to track my progress through licensure and employment using my social security number.
- ◆ I will provide Stony Brook University with current employment and contact information throughout the period of my teaching obligation.
- ◆ I will participate in outcomes assessment activities designed to evaluate the effectiveness of the Petrie Scholarship Loan Program.
- ◆ I will sign a promissory note stating my intention to uphold these commitments or repay the funds received through this scholarship loan program.
