(NOTE: we cannot give the examination if you do not have the proof of payment and the completed application form with you at the time of the exam.)

There are 3 components to the Hindi Proficiency Examination:

Speaking: Speak in standard educated Hindi.

Reading: Read selected passage(s) from a short story in Hindi written by well-known Hindi writers.

Writing: Write well, with minimal spelling errors.

(Speak with your major/minor advisor to assure that you take the exam in time to be placed in the appropriate course before graduation).
