Last day to drop or withdraw from the university without "W" (withdraw) recorded on student record.

Last day for Spring (**May**) or Summer (**August**) degree candidates to apply for graduation. West Campus Undergraduates must apply online via Solar (Click on the "Apply for Graduation" Link on your homepage.) **Only Seniors (U4) who**

have completed (posted to their records) at least 102 credits (or greater) with a declared major will be eligible to apply.
