### ARRIVAL & CHECK-IN INFORMATION

Here is some information to help you plan your trip to New York and get to the University:

If someone is meeting you at the airport, that person will know how to reach Stony Brook. If no one is meeting you, you can arrange for a limousine service to meet you and to bring you to the campus. Go to the information desk at the airport and ask about van services to Long Island. The cost from JFK Airport usually ranges from \$40.00 - \$50.00, be sure to ask about the price before getting into the van. Also, please be aware that giving the driver a tip is customary (15% of the total price is fine). Be prepared to pay the driver by cash upon your arrival at Stony Brook. Lastly, do not take a private taxi – Stony Brook is about 60 miles (90km) from New York City and the trip will cost \$200.00!

How to get to the West Apartments on campus:

From Nichols Road (97) take the SOUTH ENTRANCE (the first one on the left if traveling north on Nichols Rd.) into the campus. You will be on South Drive and pass the Dental School on your right side. Go to the traffic light and make a right on Marburger Drive. Follow the traffic circle around and keep to the left. Take the left side of the circle, which will be Circle Road. Continue until you see a sign for Roosevelt Quad on your left. Make a left onto Campus Drive and pass Wagner College on your left. Continue straight back behind Roosevelt Quad to the West Apartments Commons. The Main Quad Office is located in E Building and stands out from the rest of the complex because it's a one story annex on a three story building. Please go to this building to check in and they will tell you where your room is.

**It will be best if you arrive on campus between the hours of 12:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m.** If you arrive and the office is closed, please call the RA on Duty through the phone numbers posted on the Quad Office door.

# Living-on-Campus

## West Apartments

The West Apartments are made up of eight buildings for a total of 1170 apartments comprised of suites of doubles and singles. The West Apartments are located near the academic mall.

### Apartment Floor Plan - There are two types of apartments:

4-bedroom apartments for 4 students of the same gender to share: consist of 4 single bedrooms, living and dining areas, 2 bathrooms, and a kitchen.

6-bedroom apartments for 8 single students of the same gender to share: consist of two double bedrooms, four single bedrooms, living and dining areas, 2 bathrooms, and a kitchen.

### Furniture – Each *air-conditioned* apartment consists of the following:

Extra long twin bed for each resident

Dresser for each resident

Desk & chair for each resident with bookshelf

Full closet for each resident

Lighting fixture(s)


Window covering(s)

### Bed Linens and Laundry Service

Sheets, pillows, blankets and towels are **not included with your room.**

You must bring them with you from home or buy or rent them here. This summer there will be a **linen service** available. For a small weekly fee you can

rent your pillows, sheets, blankets and towels. You will be able to exchange **sheets and towels only** for a clean set at the end of each week.

There is also a bus service from the campus to a shopping mall if you arrive during business hours and prefer to buy your items here. There is also the Seawolves Market, a store on-campus, that you can buy various necessities.
