- Registered for full-time classes in the Fall

- Attend Week of Welcome training session.
- Submit volunteer assignments on time and for the full obligatory period.

- Wear your provided t-shirt during you volunteer assignments.
- Assist with the Week of Welcome events ( August 28<sup>th</sup> - September13th) and convocation
- Assist new and returning students with move-in process ( August 28<sup>th</sup>- August 30<sup>th</sup>), including but not limited to the following:
  - Physically unload vehicles and help carry students' personal belongings to their rooms.
  - Serve as a resource for new students and their families, answering questions and giving out directions.
  - Assist with the cleanup of your building after check-in is completed.

***NOTE:** Failure to meet all expectations may result in denied permission for early access, denied permission to participate as a Week of Welcome Volunteer in the future, and/or billing for early access.*
