## The University Provides

### **What is in a bedroom?**

## **The University Police and Fire Department prohibit the following on campus:**

- Halogen lamps/5-light multi-colored floor lamp
- Extension cords without circuit breakers
- Pets (Fish/underwater animals are the ONLY pets allowed with the exception of piranhas; no more than 15 gallons of water per tank)
- Workout weights and dumbbells
- Irons without an automatic shut off device
- Knives/weapons of any sort
- Air conditioners

## **Driving Directions to Riverhead:**

- Make a left out of campus after the guard booth
- Make a left onto Route 27 at the light
- Take Route 27, Sunrise Highway to exit 65N, CR24 north "Riverhead."
- Follow Route 24 through Flanders until traffic light at 4 lane Route 105.
- Make a right on to Route 105 and follow until 2<sup>nd</sup> light, making a left onto Route 25/CR 58 and follow into Riverhead.
- On CR 58 you will find the following stores:

## **Driving Directions to Hampton Bays:**

- Make a right out of campus after the Guard Booth
- Make a right onto Montauk Highway (CR 80) at the light
- Follow Montauk Highway over the canal and into the town of Hampton Bays
- Main Street Hamptons includes the following:

#### **Driving Directions into the town of Southampton**

-Make a right out of campus after the guard booth

-Make a left at the light onto Montauk Highway (CR 80)

-Continue on until the speed limit changes from 40mph to 25mph and Montauk Highway turns into Hill Street

-Arriving at the stop light signifies the entrance into Southampton, in Southampton you will find the following:

#### **Driving Directions to the Beach in Southampton**

-Make a right out of campus after the guard booth

-Make a left at the light onto Montauk Highway (CR 80)

-Montauk Highway turns into Hill Street

-Turn right on 1<sup>st</sup> Neck Lane

-1<sup>st</sup> Neck Lane turns into Meadow Lane

-The beach is on your left 2400ft after the slight curve of Meadow Lane
