POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT – SOCIOLOGY (Global)

Stony Brook University invites applications for a full-time position at the level of tenure-track Assistant Professor. The search is open, but the department is especially looking to augment its focus on global approaches to Sociology, and candidates with international and/or global research agendas will be preferred. Ability to teach advanced quantitative or qualitative/ethnographic methods at the graduate level is also especially desirable in addition to the applicant's topical specialization.

PhD required or anticipated completion of PhD by August 31, 2011.

Stony Brook University, home to many highly ranked graduate research programs, is located 60 miles from New York City on Long Island's scenic North Shore. Our 1,100-acre campus is home to 24,000 undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral students and more than 13,500 faculty and staff. The University is a member of the prestigious Association of American Universities and co-manager of nearby Brookhaven National Laboratory, a multidisciplinary research laboratory supporting world class scientific programs utilizing state-of-the-art facilities. Stony Brook University Medical Center is Suffolk County's only academic medical center and tertiary care provider. Many opportunities exist for collaborative research, and in some cases, joint appointments with BNL or with Medical School departments.

However, to guarantee consideration, applicants should send a letter summarizing their relevant research accomplishments, future research agenda, teaching experience, a Curriculum Vitae, three letters of recommendation, and copies of up to three writing samples (which cannot be returned) by September 20, 2010 (further written materials will be requested as needed).
