****MPS CONCENTRATION**

Students choose 18 credits with which to create a concentration in **Human Resource Management (HRM)** *or* **Environmental Management (ENM)**. Students may apply courses from the HRM Concentration toward an *Advanced Graduate Certificate (AGC) in Human Resource Management* or courses from the ENM Concentration toward an *Advanced Graduate Certificate (AGC) in Environmental Management*. The AGC is a separate credential that requires a separate application [go to: www.stonybrook.edu/spd/graduate for the preferred AGC and how to apply], and allows the student to **earn two credentials concurrently** without taking additional credits: a Master's degree and an Advanced Graduate Certificate.
