

## **SUNY-Chinese Government Scholarship Program**

The SUNY-Chinese Government Scholarship Program will continue to offer scholarships to qualified SUNY students for the **2011-2012** academic year. The duration of the scholarship is for one year or one semester. The host institutions are Sichuan University (in Chengdu, Sichuan Province) and Nanjing University (in Nanjing, Jiangsu Province). This scholarship includes tuition, on-campus accommodations, a living allowance and basic Chinese government medical insurance. The scholarship recipients will

be responsible for the SUNY-CSC Scholarship Administrative Fee, the comprehensive SUNY health and emergency assistance insurance as well as other personal expenses incurred while studying abroad in China.

The China Scholarship Council (CSC) under the Ministry of Education will implement and manage the Program in China. The Office of International Education at University of Albany is the designated organization to implement and manage the Program for the State University of New York.

### **Who is Eligible?**

- \* Candidates must be SUNY students at the time of the application
- \* Candidates must have completed at least 2 years of full-time studies at college level by the start of the program in China
- \* Candidates should have a minimum GPA of 3.0
- \* Candidates must have completed a minimum of two semesters of Chinese language study by the start of the program in China

### **What to Study?**

Students can choose to study Chinese language (at either university) or Chinese language and courses that are taught in English (at Sichuan University). Students with sufficient Chinese language background can take regular university courses in Chinese at either university.
