

FRENCH STUDY ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP



The “Mariolein Rijssenbeek Study Abroad Award” is a scholarship that encourages and supports French majors to go and study French language and culture in any Francophone destination. Priority is given (but not limited) to applicants to semester-long programs. Available financial aid amounts \$2,000 and may be broken down and shared between several candidates. Application requirements and documents are as follow:

- declared major in French
- overall GPA score of 3.00 or above
- one recommendation from a former (not current) French professor
- official transcripts of courses
- personal statement of intent
