

Mario B. Mignone Scholarship for participants in SBU's Florence University of the Arts Program

Florence University of the Arts (FUA) will offer a one semester scholarship to a deserving student participating in Stony Brook University's FUA spring/fall semester program. The scholarship will be applied to tuition and some fees.

While enrolled at FUA, the selected recipient will serve as the Stony Brook University Student Representative working in collaboration with the resident director to promote student services and SBU activities, maintain the SBU/FUA Facebook page, and oversee production of the SBU booklet.

Eligible applicants must be full time students with a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 who have completed at least three semesters of Italian language study prior to their enrollment at FUA. Students should submit a 500-700 word essay explaining why an overseas experience will be important in your career goals. Explain how you would promote an international academic experience and indicate what makes you a suitable candidate for The Mario B. Mignone Scholarship. Applicants should also submit a resume highlighting relevant work and volunteer experience, awards and extracurricular activities. Two letters of recommendation (minimum one academic) are also required.
