The following minimum criteria must be met:

- High achieving full-time matriculated sophomores and juniors at the time of application
- 3.5 or higher cumulative grade point average
- Demonstrated personal activities and/or support for the philosophy and goals of environmental sustainability
- Any Stony Brook University major
- Financial need may be taken into account

The recipient(s) will be announced on or about April 22nd – Earth Day (Earthstock Festivities) each year. The scholarship is to be used toward educational expenses at Stony Brook University the following academic year and will be applied to the student's account.
