Department of Anthropology MINOR REQUIREMENTS

(Effective Fall 2018)

The minor in anthropology is designed for students majoring in other fields who wish to take anthropology courses relevant to their interests.

- The minor requires 21 credits. At least nine credits must be in upper division courses (300 level or higher).
- **All courses for the minor (including transfer credits) must be passed with a letter grade of C or higher.**
- ANP/ANT 447 or 487 can be counted only once (max 3 credits total).
- ANP/ANT 475, 476 and 488 DO NOT count towards the minor requirements.
- Students majoring in Human Evolutionary Biology (EBH) may have a maximum of nine credits of overlap between EBH major coursework and ANT minor coursework; thus, completion of the Anthropology minor requires an additional 12 credits of coursework beyond the EBH major.

Students are encouraged to routinely meet with Anthropology Faculty/Staff regarding degree progress, providing this form and a current unofficial transcript.
