

Biology Minor

The biology minor enables students to pursue biology related topics while completing a different primary major. Completion of the minor requires a minimum of 20 credits. All courses must be taken for a letter grade and must be passed with a grade of C or higher, including at least 9 credits at the 300 level. All advanced courses must be in BIO-designator courses taken at Stony Brook.

Specific Course Requirements:

- At least two of the following core lecture courses:
 - BIO 201
 - BIO 202
 - BIO 203
- Two semesters of fundamental lab including BIO 204, and either BIO 205 or BIO 207
- At least 9 credits of Upper Division courses in Biology, in at least two of the four areas (I-IV)
- Any additional courses as needed to reach the 20 credits required
