

## CREDIT-BEARING INTERNSHIPS

### ENROLLMENT STEPS IN A CREDIT-BEARING INTERNSHIP:

There are two ways to receive credits for an internship:

- The Career Center EXT 288/488 Internship Program
- Departmental/Academic Major: NON-EXT[ex. BUS 488, PSY 488]

In order to get permission/enroll in a credit bearing internship, students need to:

- ✓ Identify, apply and accept an internship (ON or OFF campus)
- ✓ Secure a faculty sponsor [academic credit is awarded for the learning achieved]
- ✓ Report an internship in HANDSHAKE or receive permission from the academic department



### CAREER CENTER EXT 288/488/588 INTERNSHIP COURSES:

#### Eligibility:

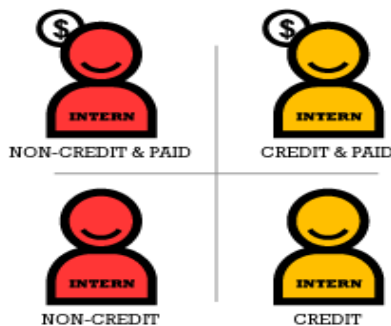
- For EXT 288: Completion of WRT 102 or equivalent
- For EXT 488: Completion of 57 credits with at least U3 standing
- For EXT 588: Enrollment and matriculation in the SBU graduate program
