# Master of Public Health Program

**THE PROGRAM IN PUBLIC HEALTH AT STONY BROOK MEDICINE** is proud to offer the Master of Public Health (MPH) degree program. To ensure that all students have a broad understanding of the basic areas of public health, every student is required to complete all MPH Core courses and a Concentration. Students receive training in the five basic, discipline-specific, competency areas of public health: biostatistics, environmental health, epidemiology, health policy and management, and the social and behavioral sciences. Students also receive core competency education in informatics and communication, professionalism, systems thinking, research methods, and problem solving. The program offers concentrations in Population Health Analytics, Health Policy & Management, and Community Health. Courses are held in the evening, Monday-Thursday, beginning at 5:30 pm. The program includes required summer courses, in addition to full semester fall/spring courses. Full-time students can complete the degree in two years. Part-time options are available.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- Completed SOPHAS online application
- Official transcripts from all schools attended
- Minimum 3.0 GPA
- Resume or CV
- Personal Statement
- Three letters of recommendation

## International students must also submit:

- Foreign transcript evaluation from World Education Services (WES)
- TOEFL or IELTS scores for students who completed undergraduate education outside of the United States
