- Demonstrate financial need as determined by a current FAFSA application, reviewed and confirmed by the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarship Services
- Demonstrate clear leadership ability through participation in on-campus or off-campus activities; examples include: serving in a leadership role in an organization, participating in a project or academic endeavor or contributing to a community service initiative

Recipient may forfeit the scholarship if he/she:

- Does not enroll full-time in the semester/academic year for which the scholarship is in effect
- Fails to remain in good academic standing
- Is found guilty of academic dishonesty and/or violation of the University Student Code of Conduct
- Fails to maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 as calculated at the end of each academic year.
