Indirect costs are not paid directly to the University. They are average regional costs based on the consumer price index.

Transportation allowance may cover the cost of operating and maintaining a car, the costs of daily trips to and from campus, the cost of trips to permanent residence, and the cost of bus and parking permits.

Personal expenses includes clothing, personal maintenance, grooming aids, and recreation.
