The William and Theresa Meyer Award for Asian and Middle Eastern Studies is given to a student engaged in any form of humanities or social studies focusing on the Arabic-speaking countries, Israel, Turkey, Iran, Afghanistan and Asia, the Indian subcontinent, Burma, Thailand, China, Korea and Japan. The award is not primarily for those studying international or current foreign affairs.

In addition to completing and providing the requested signatures on this form, the nomination file should include:

1. Two letters of support, one of which should come from a faculty advisor
2. Student resume and a comprehensive statement detailing current work and future plans related to the theme of the award
3. Official or unofficial copy of your academic transcript. Student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
