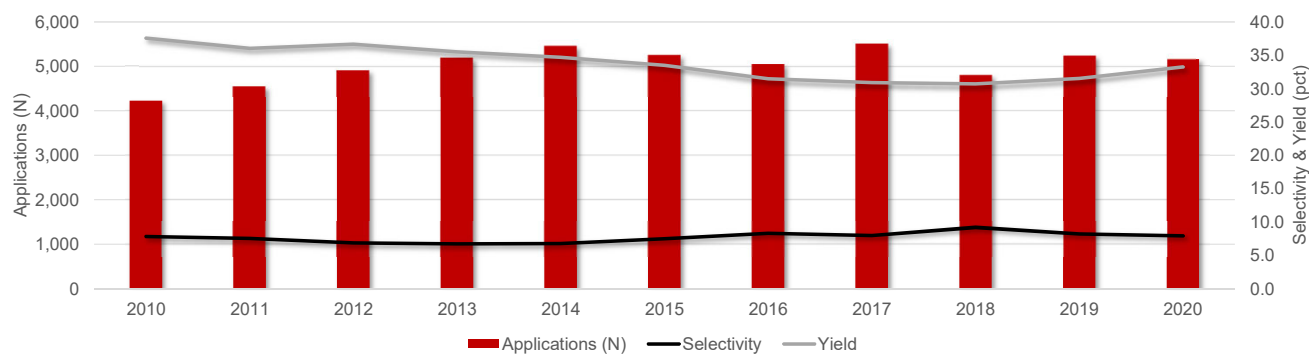

***Prior to January 2013, the old MCAT exam included a fourth section, the Writing Sample. This section tested examinees' ability to develop a central idea, synthesize concepts and ideas, present ideas cohesively and logically, and write clearly following accepted writing conventions. Applicants who took the old MCAT exam prior to January 20 13 will have MCAT results for this fourth section, reported on an alphabetic scale that ranges from J (low) to T (high)."

The percentile ranks of scores are the percentages of test takers who received the same scores or lower scores. The percentile ranks are updated on May 1 every year to reflect the results from previous calendar year(s).
