## Filename protocol

Following is an explanation of file names used in this study.
Each file name can be broken down in different parts, as shown below:

## (1): Recording session number

Since our participants were recorded 3 (or 5) times over the course of two years, the number in this part indicates which recording session the data are from (e.g., CB1 is the first recording for this subject t, CB3 is the third recording, etc.)

## (2): Time point recording was made

Indicates which semester the recording was made; e.g., Fall 2015, Spring 2016, etc. This information is needed to select the materials that match the recording since later recording sessions sometimes included additional words or tasks.

## (3): Participant number

Normally, users of our data will be searching for specific subject numbers, based on their interest in, e.g., higher or lower proficiency speakers.

## (4): Type of experiment

For example, focus dialogue, wordlist, etc.

## Spontaneous speech

All recordings related to spontaneous speech are labeled as "Interview" in (4). The next page outlines some questions that were used to elicit participants' extended responses.

Sample Questions:

- How was this semester?
- What was your teaching assignment?
- What was the course about? What did your students learn?
- Did you teach in front of students? What concepts did you teach?
- Did you have office hours? Did you have many students visiting?
- Have you attended any academic conferences?
- Did you present your work?
- Have you had any other academic experiences?
- What are your plans for this summer break?
- Do you contact anyone when you get sick? Who are they?
- Is there anyone on campus that you could contact when you need help for something?
- When you think about changes that have happened in your life in the past two years, what would be the first one that comes to your mind?
