FRRPC Resolution 22.01 Enabling Access to Faculty Meetings and Colloquia/Seminars

Whereas faculty participation at Faculty Meetings is an indispensable aspect of academic governance, and

Whereas access to departmental academic events, such as Colloquia and Seminars, is important to the intellectual vitality of academia,

Therefore be it resolved that, to afford maximal opportunities to attend and participate, departments are encouraged to offer all otherwise in-person Departmental Faculty Meetings and Colloquia/Seminars in hybrid mode, with remote accessibility via Zoom or equivalent.
