We educate the next generations of communication, journalism, and media leaders, practitioners, scholars, and professionals.


We support and integrate effective science and health communication research and practice and **explore**, **clarify**, **and strengthen the role of engaged communication in society**.

SoCJ Fall Enrollment





SoCJ Student Credit Hours




