Requirements for the Minor in Health, Medicine, and Society (MHS)

Students may be Sociology Majors as well as choosing to “Minor” in Health, Medicine, and Society. Only Soc 105, Soc 200 and Soc 201 can be applied to both the major and the minor.

All courses for the minor must be passed with a letter grade of C or higher. Completion of the minor requires 21 credits. At least 9 of the 21 credits must be taken at Stony Brook and

at least three of the courses must be taken at the upper-division level.
