

2023 Stony Brook University West Campus Conference and Summer Housing Options ADULT

Review the options below and contact the appropriate individuals if you are interested. We will provide tentative commitments on projected space availability. A signed Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) with a final projection is the final confirmation of our space availability and your anticipated occupancy.

West Campus (Stony Brook, NY) Options

1. Conferences - Adult 18+

Who it is for: 18 years or older conference groups on campus for three nights minimum and up to the full conference housing term (May 30-August 4, 2023). The minimum group size is ten individuals.

What is included: Suite style, air-conditioned rooms housing 4-6 individuals in double or single occupancy bedrooms based on location. Suites include a bathroom in the unit. Linens are included in the rate. For the 2023 season, we do not have Chávez and Tubman available, so our single option will be in West Apartments.

2. Sponsored Summer Student Housing 18+ by the start of Session 2 Extended (June 20, 2023)

Who it is for: Current Stony Brook University Students whose summer housing is being paid for by another office instead of billed to the student account. Offices with summer visiting scholars that receive an SBU ID and summer term activation (minimum three weeks before arrival) are housed in summer housing.

Housing is based on standard summer housing beginning and end dates or a pre-agreed upon arrival and departure date that aligns with Campus Residences' operational capabilities and needs. Minimum stay of 4 weeks.

Spring off-campus residents cannot arrive until the day before their academic commitment and no earlier than May 21. Students must depart no later than the day after their program ends and no later than August 18 at 4pm unless they are fall residents maintaining housing until the start of the fall semester.

What is included: Apartment style, air-conditioned rooms housing 4-6 individuals in single occupancy bedrooms based in West Apartments. Will be housed with other summer students but will attempt to house based on your group when possible and does not impact other operational needs. Linens are not provided. Students are billed on their student account if they are paying themselves or if the office directly pays their student or student account.
