Payment is due in full prior to the program start date. Due to inflation and fluctuations in exchange rate, actual costs may differ. You will **NOT** receive a paper bill. After registering for Summer courses, you will be able to access your bill via the SOLAR System.

Billable SBU Costs: : Program requires 2 classes. 4 credits per class.
