

Parking on Campus

If you park on campus, your vehicle must display a valid parking permit, and be operated within the guidelines specified by the Stony Brook University (SBU) Parking Rules and Regulations. Parking permits are color-coded and correspond to signs posted at the entrance to each parking lot. A legal parking space is defined by 2 parallel lines. Please refer to the map inside for information on parking lot locations and complete color designations.

Obtaining Your Permit

Permits are acquired on-line at our website: www.stonybrook.edu/parking or in person at either the Southampton campus or the Stony Brook campus.

- You will need your Southampton ID card and Department of Motor Vehicle Registration in order to complete the application process.
- Only one parking hangtag will be issued per employee/student.
- The permit belongs to the individual and not the vehicle, so you can move the hangtag from vehicle to vehicle.
- You can register up to 4 vehicles on one permit.
- Only vehicles registered in New York State will be eligible to register and receive a permit via the website. Applicants with non-New York license plates must bring their vehicle registration and Stony Brook Southampton ID to Parking Services, located in the Southampton Student Services Office, room 104 in the Student Center, or at the Stony Brook campus at 254 Administration Bldg.
- All permits requested online will be available for pick-up at the Student Services office in Southampton 48 hours after the request has been submitted.
- A faculty/staff permit will allow access to faculty/staff parking at both Stony Brook Southampton AND Stony Brook University.
- Southampton commuter and resident students will have commuter parking privileges at Stony Brook University.

Visitor Parking

Weekdays and all weekend anyone may park in any unrestricted lot or space in the main parking lot (Lot A) to the left of the main entrance.

ADA Accessible Parking

All lots have ADA accessible parking spaces. Only the person who is issued a Disabilities Permit may use it.

SBU Transit

Stony Brook University operates SBU Transit which provides transportation throughout the Stony Brook, Research & Development Park and Southampton campuses. SBU Transit operates on a variety of schedules, depending on the calendar day. Directions by Train

Take the Long Island Railroad's Montauk Branch from Jamaica Station in New York City to Southampton. (Service from Manhattan's Penn Station to Jamaica runs frequently.) The campus is a short taxi ride from the station. For rates and times, visit www.mta.nyc.ny.us/lirr

Directions by Car

Take I-495 (Long Island Expressway) east to Exit 70, then turn right on County Road 111; follow the signs for State Route 27 East/Montauk - Sunrise Highway. Take Route 27 East and proceed 19 miles to Southampton Campus. Make right at the traffic light onto Tuckahoe Road. Make second right at the main entrance.
